Our Mission Statement What is the Avon & Somerset Bleed Kit Partnership

Avon and Somerset Police have joined up with HeartSafe and NHS England South West to provide emergency bleed kits in public spaces across local communities.

These kits are easily accessible to help anyone respond quickly in life-threatening situations involving severe bleeding, such as from traffic accidents, falls, stabbings, animal bites, or other injuries.

With 24/7 availability, these kits empower the public to act in the crucial first moments after an injury, potentially saving lives before emergency responders arrive.



Did You Know? On average, you have as little as 3-4 minutes to stop a catastrophic bleed.

Our Guiding Principles

- Immediate Availability: Our kits are kept in unlocked dispensers, making them instantly accessible in an emergency.
- Simplicity: Make kits easy to find, understand, and use during emergencies.
- O Up-to-date mapping: Share up to date locations of kits to boost community awareness and engagement.
- Affordability: Multiple options of dispensers and cabinets makes it more affordable for a range of communities and businesses.
- Orive Visibility: Highly visible kits raise awareness within communities
- Long-term Solution: Our legacy funding means we have a comprehensive management system for the kits which includes registration, mapping, and ongoing support for repairs and replacements.
- National Reach: Our hope is that this easy provision model can be rolled out across police forces and communities nationally.
- Branding Opportunities: Kits can feature branding from charities, community groups, or businesses to show support (see pg. 17).
- Be everywhere: Reach as many communities as possible.
- Grow the partnership: More kits = more opportunity to save lives.








SWASFT Collaboration South West Ambulance Service Joins The Partnership to Improve Emergency Response

South West Ambulance Service (SWASFT) have become a key partner in the bleed control kit initiative, offering vital support and advice. SWASFT has endorsed the kits for being straightforward in an emergency and the only appropriate solution of their kind.



Through collaboration with SWASFT we have adapted the body mapping card contained within all bleedkits which has now been endorsed by medical professionals as best practice.

Control Room Ready How We Are Helping Save Lives...

Police and Ambulance Command & Control rooms have now gone live with a mapping system which provides real time plotting of bleedkit sites, meaning members of the public can be told the exact locations when they call 999 and then be told how to use them. **This is the first collaboration of its kind in the UK**.

Why is all of this important?

Recently, a young person was stabbed in central Bristol.

Despite a bleed kit being just yards away, bystanders did not know it was there, and the victim had to be carried over a mile to hospital.

Thankfully, they survived.

This situation highlights the importance of SWASFT's involvement. With the new mapping system, the public will be promptly directed to nearby bleed kits in emergencies.



We are now working with key stakeholders such as SWASFT to scale the model nationally as best practice and the best solution to respond to catastrophic bleed incidents.

Where are they needed?


Bleed control kits are vital in managing emergencies involving severe bleeding, this can occur in a range of environments and situations.

For example:

- Workplaces: Especially in industries such as construction, manufacturing, and hospitality, where sharp tools and machinery are used.
- Crime: Injuries caused by a knife/violent offences, etc.
- Schools and Universities: In the event of an accident in classroom, during sports, or unfortunate incidents of violence.
- A Highways and Roads: For use in traffic accidents, where timely medical intervention can save lives before emergency services arrive.
- Rural and Remote Locations: Areas where access to immediate medical care is limited, making it vital for travellers or residents to manage emergencies independently.
- Outdoor Activities: Hiking, camping, and hunting, where cuts, falls, or animal attacks can cause severe bleeding.
- Home Use: Household accidents, such as cuts from kitchen knives or power tools, where immediate action is required to stop bleeding.
- Industrial Facilities: Where machinery or hazardous materials can cause serious injuries.
- Agricultural Operations: Farms and processing plants have risks from machinery and tools.
- Forestry and Logging: High-risk of cuts or punctures from chainsaws, equipment and falling trees.

HeartSafe have created an interactive public facing map to mirror the success of their AED Locator map used to familiarise communities with the location of the nearest defibrillator.

The Bleed Kit map now shows all locations and is updated daily with any newly registered kits.


Locations are added via a simple web form, we also add 'coming soon' and 'restricted access' locations to show where we are expanding the scheme. The map also has a search feature so people can easily identify the closest bleed kits by entering an address.

It's so simple, just follow 'register your bleed kit' and leave the rest to us.


The attention each kit gets...

Legacy Fund - Future Kit Management



Avon and Somerset Police have agreed a legacy fund for the ongoing, **free** management and replacement of these Bleed Kits in their region


The ongoing management scheme incorporates:

- Regular checking of all sites on local policing patrols.
- A system with HeartSafe which notifies when items in each kit with expiry dates need to be replaced.
- A system with HeartSafe to alert local policing teams when a kit has been used.
- A simple QR scan system to allow replacement kits to be reordered in the event of usage, theft or damage.
- Free installation if required, however self installation and registration instructions are provided to enable a more timely delivery and installation'









Businesses Like Yours... The Mall, Cribbs Causeway



The core of our mission. A simple, easy to understand kit of life-saving essentials designed for use under 999 guidance to help treat a catastrophic trauma patient until emergency services arrive.

Developed with the support of the NHS and 999 emergency services, this kit is designed to include essentials for use by untrained members of the public.



Instructions

The first instruction is to call 999, so any intervention is supported by a call handler with the kit aimed to help control the bleed in the few minutes before an ambulance arrives.

Printed Instruction Card with Quick Reference



Together with HeartSafe we have created a set of instructions that are clear and encourage best practice for use by someone who is likely to be in a state of panic.


Simply follow the coloured dots that allows for easy identification of all contents when opened and quick application of what is needed to best help the patient.

Inside The Bleed Kit

NHS South Western Ambulance Service Approved BS8559-1 Compliant Critical Injury Pack

Working together with HeartSafe, we devised a community Bleed Kit that can be used by any untrained member of the public with 999 operator assistance.

Given that most members of the public will likely not have any training we prepared simple colour coded steps so that the instructions are clear and easy to use when someone is in a critical situation.





Some people have difficulty with listed buildings, where community bleed kits are needed most. For this reason, we have designed a new adaptor, a Standalone Model 2 Bleed Kit dispenser, around poles of different diameters, from 75mm up to 200mm, so a street sign type posts up to a telegraph or CCTV pole. It will also work on railings.

We have been notified by **South Western Ambulance Service NHS Foundation Trust** that one of our bleed kits was successfully used to help treat a patient with a serious head injury in the Keynsham area today.

The bleed kit, which was one of 125 funded by Avon & Somerset Police & Crime Commissioner in 2024, was identified by the emergency medical dispatcher on their mapping system and a member of pubic was guided to the kits location (same street) and it was then used to control a serious bleed until the arrival of the Ambulance are


We are also grateful to the guardian of the kit also contacting us to provide the same information and to request a replacement, which has been arranged.
